On its way through Sant Sadurní, the path leads to Can Mas de la Riera, the Codorniu cava winery, Raventós i Blanc lake and oak tree monument, Colònia Pons (estate), Can Romeu, Monistrol and Can Catassús, which are exceptional spots along the river.

Sant Sadurní d'Anoia

The municipality of Sant Sadurní d'Anoia is located in the Alt Penedès region, inland but with the coast near at hand. It is surrounded by a stunning natural environment of vineyards just 45 kilometres from Barcelona and 60 kilometres from Tarragona, and is an almost essential stop-off point for anyone travelling north to south across Catalonia.

The vineyard landscape is the municipality's most striking feature and the cava wineries are a major attraction in terms of their architecture, production and cultural activities. The fact is that, having survived the phylloxera devastation in the late 19th century, and through a combination of progress and artisanship in the making of sparkling wine, Sant Sadurní has become the bubbles capital.

A walk through Sant Sadurní reveals the architectural jewels that the cava industry has left behind from its various eras. Being emblematic of Catalan modernism and signature pieces by leading artists of the time, the cava wineries have become living museums in themselves. At the Cava Interpretation Centre, CIC Fassina, in the heart of the municipality, visitors will be able to find out about the history and emotions that cava inspires. If there is an ideal time of year to visit Sant Sadurní, it is at the end of summer. This is when the wineries load up their tractors with the grape harvest and come to the Sant Sadurní fairs and the Phylloxera Festival, held the 7th and 8th of September. October also sees Cavatast and Cava Week, which offer a wide range of wine-tourism experiences centred around the cava culture.

If you just want to disconnect, Sant Sadurní provides the chance for many great walks, such as around the Can Codorniu lake and following the special Routes of the Capital of Cava.

If you have never visited us before or want to rediscover us, we invite you to come and savour Sant Sadurní while having fun with the experiences offered by the cava culture: tours, tastings, walks and adventure among the vineyards... Get ready, glass in hand, to enjoy Sant Sadurní d'Anoia to the fullest!
